CIRCULAR

1. As per the directives of Delhi Govt., Last day of every month is celebrated as a "Dry Day for Tobacco in Delhi". Similarly it is also being celebrated in JNU with awareness cum enforcement drive with special focus on the following violations and appropriate actions are taken as per COTPA, 2003/Delhi Act 1996.
 - a. Sale of loose cigarette / bidi / tobacco.
 - b. Sale of tobaccos to minor less than 18 years of age & absence of board mentioning that sale of tobaccos to children less than 18 years of age is prohibited.
 - c. Tobacco sale within 100 mtr radius of educational institutes and health facility.
 - d. Smoking in public places.
 - e. Sale of banned chewable tobaccos & inform deptt. of Food Safety, GNCTD.
 - f. Direct/indirect advertisement of tobaccos.
 - g. Illicit trade / absence of mandatory 85% pictorial health warnings on tobacco packets.
 - h. Special focus on e-cigarette / hookah bars.
2. Sensitization meeting / training / workshop are also organized under Tobacco Control Program.
3. This is being issued with the approval of the Competent Authority.
